

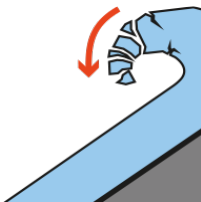

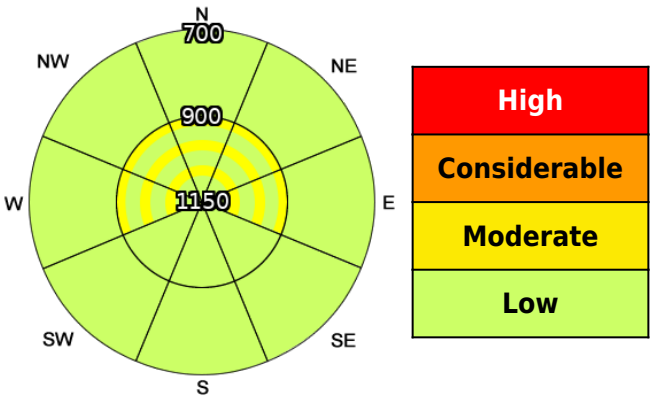
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. Fresh snow deposits will be light. Localised wet snow instabilities will be possible on steep ground, mainly on West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Remaining cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A fresh wind, initially Southerly then progressively backing North-Easterly through the period. Generally dry overnight then showers, heavy at times, falling as wet snow on the tops and as rain at lower levels. The freezing level will be around 1200 metres.
