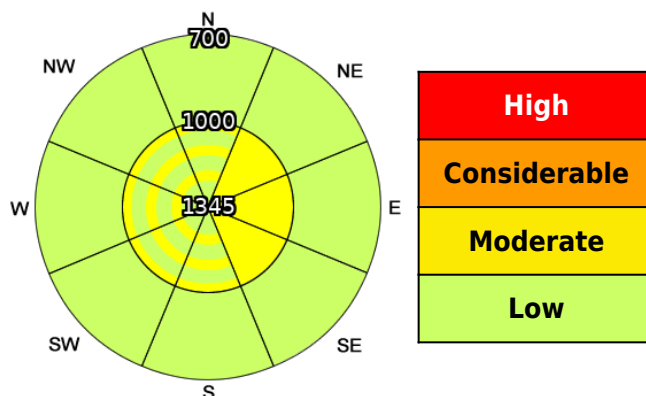
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Generally shallow areas of moderately bonded windslab will build on many aspects above 1000 metres. Most affected will be North-East to South-East. Some minor surface instabilities will occur on steep slopes and gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Throughout the period showers will fall as snow above about 1000 metres. The freezing level will be around 1100 metres. Northerly winds will back Westerly.
