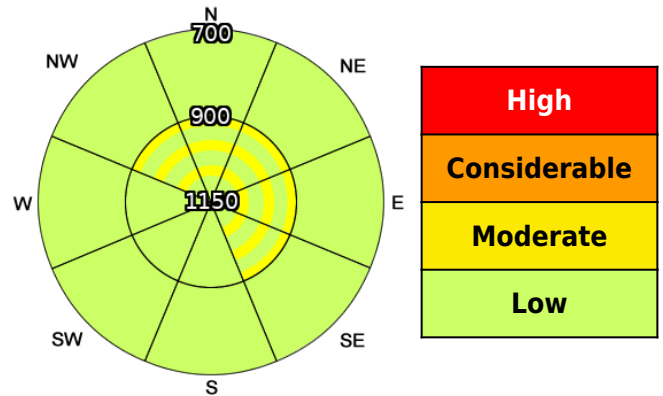

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all levels and consolidate. Fresh snow deposits will be light. Localised wet snow instabilities will be possible on steep ground, mainly on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Remaining cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be fresh, initially Northerly backing progressively Westerly through the period. Intermittent showers throughout the period will fall as wet snow on the summits and as rain below this level. The freezing level will be around 1200 metres overnight falling to 1000 metres in the day.
