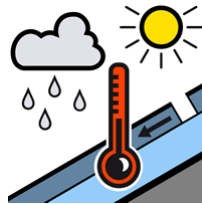

Wind Slab



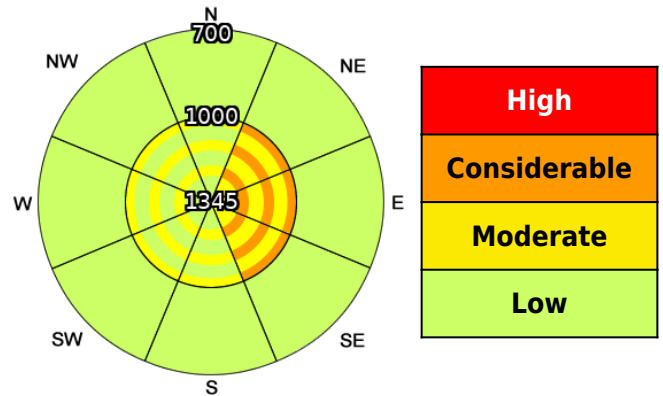
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh areas of unstable windslab will form mainly on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 1000m. Surface instabilities will develop on slopes exposed to solar radiation. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Southerly winds will veer to the West and gradually strengthen. There will be a period of heavy showers, falling as snow above 800m.
