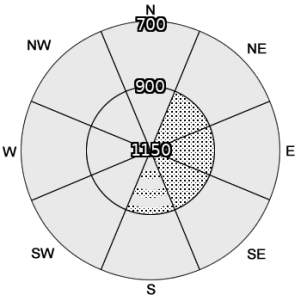


Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Wed 06/04/2016 TO 18:00HRS Thu 07/04/2016



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
Very High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
High	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
Considerable	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
Moderate	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
Low	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

Forecast Weather Influences

Showers will continue overnight and through the day. These will fall as snow above about 900 metres. The freezing level will be around summit levels. Strong winds will be from the North-West.

Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Areas of moderately bonded windslab will be deposited on East to South aspects above 900 metres. Older deposits of moderately bonded slab will also remain on North-East aspects. Below 900 metres the snowpack will be moist and generally stable. Fresh cornices will be poorly bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

Observed Avalanche Hazard - Wed 06/04/2016

Observed Weather Influences

Through the day showers fell as snow above around 800 metres. The freezing level was around 950 metres. Moderate to strong winds were from the West.

Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard

Through the day areas of moderately bonded windslab were being deposited on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. The tops of slopes and gullies are most affected. Fresh cornices are quite weak. The avalanche hazard is Moderate.

Mountain Conditions

Observed Mountain Travel Conditions	Fresh snow above 800 metres. Generally poor visibility at higher areas although there were occasional breaks in the cloud. Winds 20 -30 mph.
Comments	Showery conditions continuing.
