

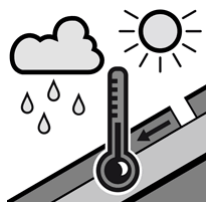

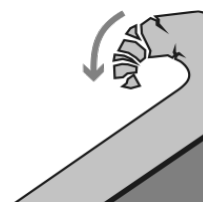

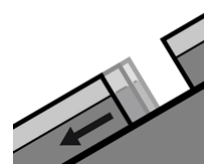
Wind Slab

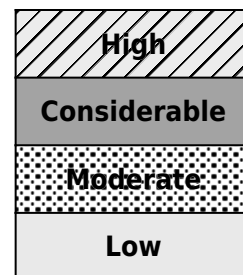

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will improve in many locations overnight. A little thin new windslab is possible at the top of very steep North East through East to South East aspects above 950m; accumulations expected to be thin and localised. Some residual wet snow instability in a few locations below 850m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds falling light Westerly overnight, increasing to moderate Southerly by afternoon. A little light snowfall is possible during the period otherwise dry. Colder overnight then a steady rise in freezing level to around summits by the end of the day.

Comments

Another day of poor visibility though occasional breaks between showers.
