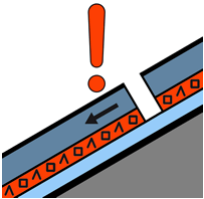


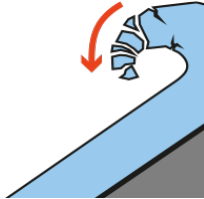

Avalanche Problems



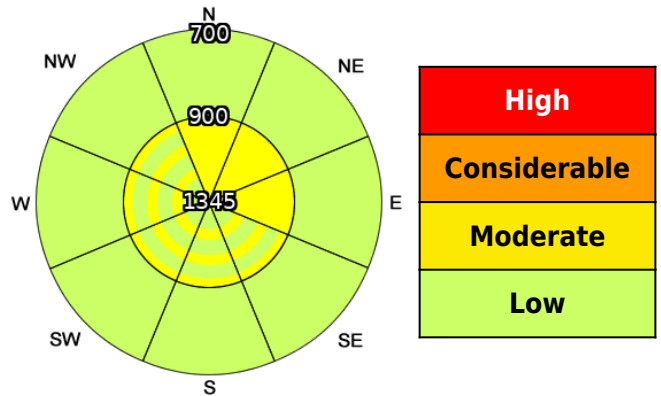
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unconsolidated snow will fall on all aspects above 700m. Areas of windslab will develop on steep North to East aspects above 900m. Isolated areas of moderately bonded windslab will remain on other aspects. Cornices will be present and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Decreasing moderate to light Southerly winds becoming South-West during the day. Overnight rain falling as snow above 700m will mostly die out to leave occasional showers. The freezing level will fluctuate around 700m.
