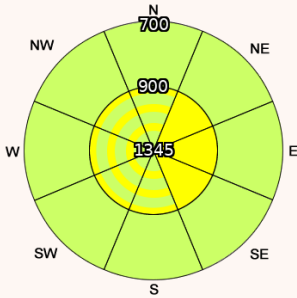


**Avalanche Hazard Forecast - FOR PERIOD 18:00HRS Sat 09/04/2016 TO 18:00HRS Sun 10/04/2016**



Hazard Level	Avalanche Probability
<b>Very High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. Numerous very large, often extremely large natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>High</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches will occur. In some cases, numerous large, often very large sized natural avalanches can be expected.
<b>Considerable</b>	Natural and human triggered avalanches possible, in some cases large, in isolated cases very large sized natural avalanches are possible.
<b>Moderate</b>	Very large sized natural avalanches are unlikely. Human triggering possible in indicated steep places.
<b>Low</b>	Only small and medium sized natural avalanches are possible. Human triggering possible in steep, extreme terrain.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a dry night the morning will be wet with snow above 800m. Light Easterly winds increasing slightly during the day. The freezing level will be around 800m rising to around the summits.

**Forecast Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected overnight with remaining instabilities on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Shallow accumulations of windslab may form on other aspects during the day. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Observed Avalanche Hazard - Sat 09/04/2016**

**Observed Weather Influences**

Overnight snow and rain cleared leaving dry, bright and sunny conditions with occasional snow flurries over the summits. Light South-West winds. The freezing level rose to around the summits.

**Observed Snow Stability and Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh unconsolidated snow on all aspects above 600m. Moderately bonded windslab on North-East to South-East aspects above 900m. Localised instabilities remain on other aspects. Cornices prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard is Moderate

**Mountain Conditions**

**Observed Mountain Travel Conditions**

Fresh soft snow conditions on variable cover, generally good above 900m. Good visibility. Winds approx 10mph or less.

**Comments**
