

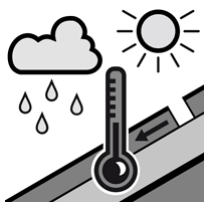

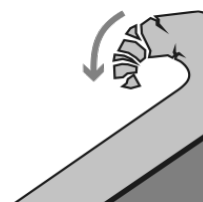

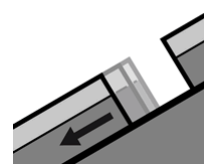
Wind Slab

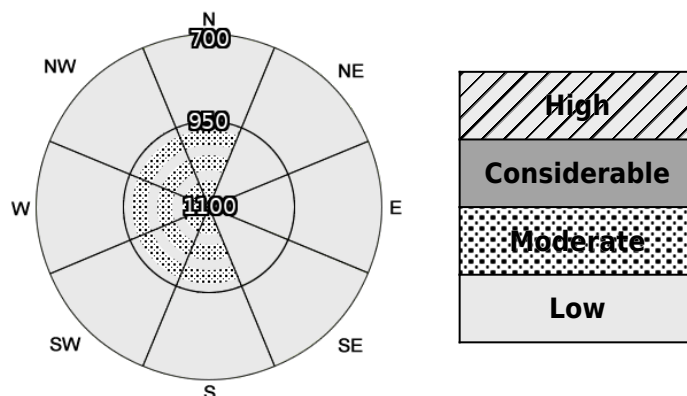

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old exposed snowpack will remain moist and well stabilised in most locations. Localised wet snow instability later in the day on steepest South through West to North aspects above 950m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A few light snow showers overnight and during the morning. Winds will be light to moderate Easterly becoming moderate to fresh later. Cold but freezing level rising to summits in the afternoon.

Comments

Overcast on Saturday morning but brighter later. A covering of fresh snow above 700m.
