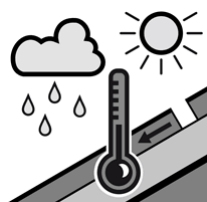


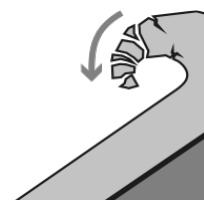

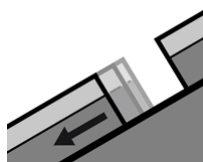

Wet Snow



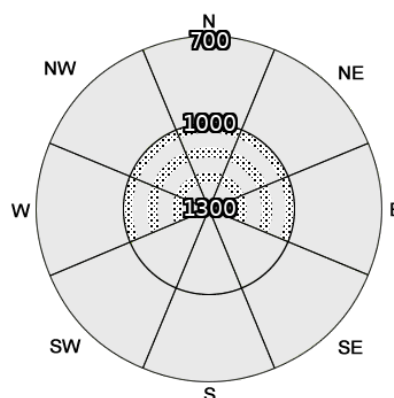

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will thaw at all levels with instabilities affecting areas of steep and convex terrain especially on West through North to North-Easterly aspects above 1000 metres. Surface instabilities will affect many steep and sun exposed slopes. Cornices will be prone to collapse. Glide cracks will continue to widen on East aspects. Elsewhere the snowpack will be soft but generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions are expected with long spells of sunshine during the day. Moderate to strong East-South-East winds will back to the East. The freezing level will be above the summits.
