




**Avalanche Problems**




Persistent Weak Layers

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Some surface instabilities will remain on steep slopes above 900 metres. North-East to South-East aspects will be most affected. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain generally dry, although with the risk of a light shower during the afternoon. The freezing level will rise above the summits through the day. Moderate winds will be from the East.

**Comments**

Feels very spring like below about 700 metres, but very much still winter on the tops.
