



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old exposed snowpack will remain well consolidated in most locations. Some potential for minor full depth avalanches on selected steep North East to East aspects below 800m. Remaining cornices over steep North East to East aspects will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation is forecast. Winds will be East North Easterly moderate to strong. Freezing level at or just above summits, though a local overnight frost is possible.
