



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 14/04/2016

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Above 800 metres the snowpack will remain frozen and stable. Below this level it will continue to slowly thaw. A dusting of soft snow will remain above 900 metres, but deposits will not be significant. The snowpack will be generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to remain dry throughout the period. The freezing level will drop to around 700 metres overnight, before rising to 900 metres through the day. Moderate North-Easterly winds will ease and back Northerly.
