

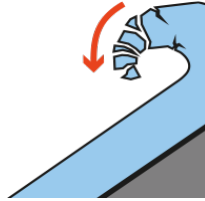

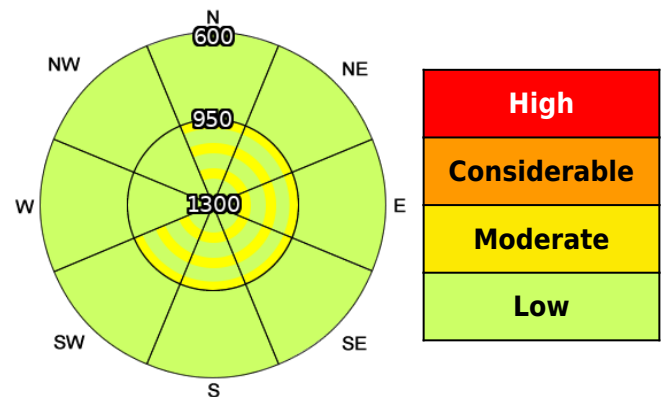
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general stability will be mostly good in all areas. Any localised instabilities will be within newly deposited surface layers, confined to steep, convex areas on East through South to South-West aspects above 950 metres. Additional unstable windslab will form through the day around corrie rims on North to East aspects this should gradually improve in stability. Surface instabilities will develop on sun exposed slopes. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers dying out overnight on strong North backing West-South-West winds. During the day the freezing level will rise from 600 to 1000 metres, mostly dry with some sun shine, moderate South-West winds will strengthen later with some snow showers.
