

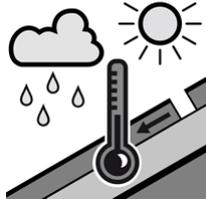

#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 01/05/2016


##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Initially drifting snow with new windslab developing on North-West to North-Easterly aspects above 950 metres. During the temperature rise these areas will become more unstable especially in steep convex terrain. Localised windslab will develop in other areas due to cross loading. Cornices will be unstable. Elsewhere the snowpack will become mostly wind scoured with surface instabilities affecting sheltered steep terrain. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



##### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to above the summits by early morning with strong becoming gale force South-South-West winds backing to the South, some light snowfall above 800 metres. During the day mostly dry, South-West winds will ease, light sleet and rain towards the end of the day.

##### Comments

Excellent conditions on the hill today. Mild with gales up until Monday before turning cooler again
