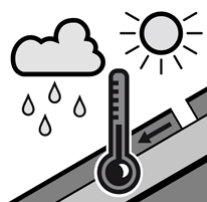


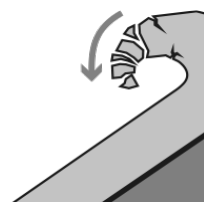

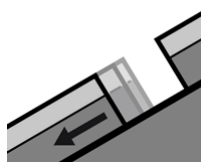
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow



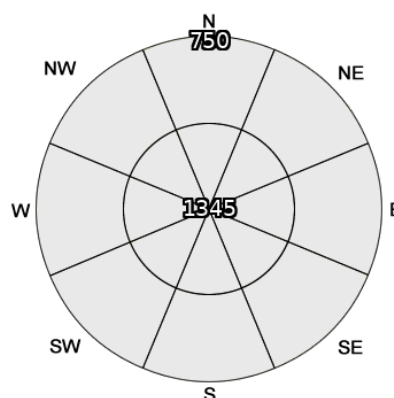
Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. Localised wet snow surface instabilities will be present on very steep slopes, particularly on aspects exposed to the sun. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse in the warm temperatures. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate Easterly winds. Showers this evening, falling as rain at all levels, then dry. Freezing level above the summits, becoming very warm tomorrow with summit temperature up to 11 deg C.

Comments

Similar conditions will persist for the next few days with cornice collapse, rock fall, and wet snow surface instabilities likely in the warm temperatures.
