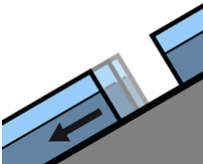

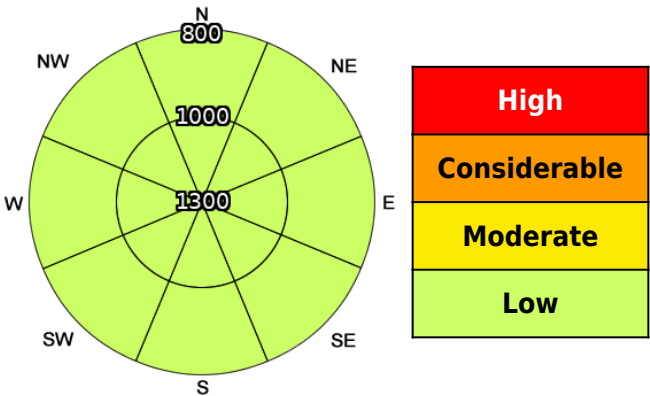

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack, with greatest accumulations above 800 metres, will continue to rapidly deplete in the warmer temperatures, although soft, it will be generally stable throughout. Surface instabilities will develop later on steep sun affected slopes with avalanche sloughs likely. Cornices that overhang many North aspects will be prone to collapse and Glide cracks will continue to develop in deeper accumulations on mostly Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A warm day in prospect with strong Easterly winds on the tops, dry with a freezing level well above the summits.
