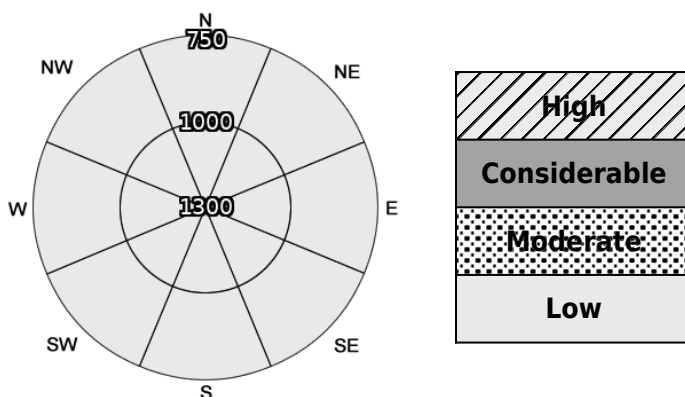


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 17/12/2016

Forecast Weather Influences

Some light snow flurries above 900 metres during the early part of the evening. This will clear to leave dry conditions with hill fog. Light Westerly winds will increase strong to gale force and back to the South-West. The freezing level will rise from 900 metres to well above summits during the early part of the morning.

Any new snow expected to melt during temperature rise tomorrow. A mild weekend in prospect.
