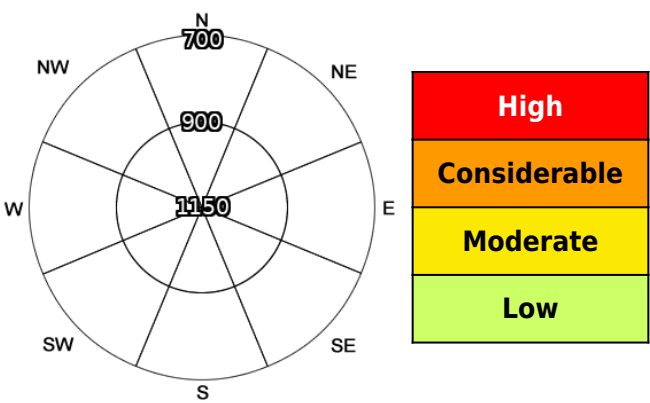


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 19/12/2016

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any new snow amounts are not expected to be significant.
No avalanche hazard is forecast.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will be well above the summits at first lowering through the day to the level of the highest tops which may lead to a dusting of snow. The wind will be generally fresh, gusting strong, from a Southerly direction gradually veering to the West. Some light showers of rain in the morning, followed by drier conditions in the afternoon.

Comments

Summit temperatures higher than valley temperatures due to an inversion. Becoming cooler on Monday afternoon with the prospect of some precipitation which may fall initially as snow.
