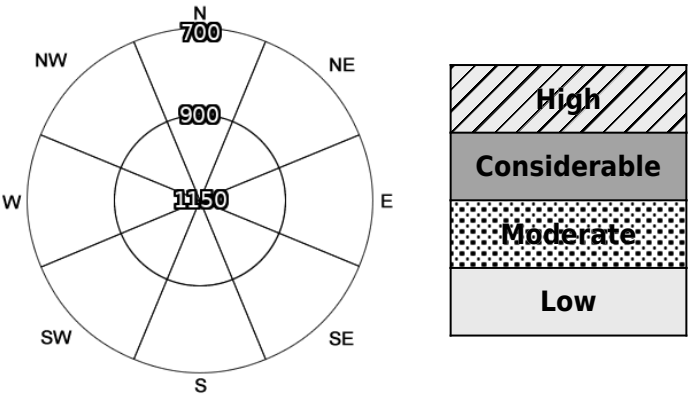


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/12/2016

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Any new snow amounts are not expected to be significant. No avalanche hazard is forecast.



Forecast Weather Influences

The fresh Westerly wind will back Southerly and strengthen from the early hours becoming gale force during the day. Dry for most of the period but precipitation from mid-afternoon will bring some snow above 700 metres. The freezing level will be around 500 to 700 metres until rising above summit levels at the end of the period.

Comments

Becoming colder and very windy with snow showers later in the week.
