
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will become more firm and frozen in the colder temperatures. Fresh unstable windslab will be deposited in the afternoon with greatest accumulations on North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light South-West wind initially backing South and increasing overnight to become very strong during the day. Mainly dry with snow falling above around 700 metres from mid-afternoon onwards. Close to freezing above 900 metres with little change of temperature with height.

Comments

Snow forecast from tomorrow afternoon onwards.
