### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 20/12/2016


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Remaining snow patches will refreeze in the colder conditions; initially the ground otherwise will remain bare of snow. Late afternoon snowfall will then form unstable windslab in sheltered hollows, gullies and around coire rims on North-West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. Areas gaining depth are not expected to be extensive. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will increase in strength overnight to be strong South-South-Westerly during the day. It is expected to be dry for most of the period but with snow falling above around 700 metres from mid-afternoon.

#### Comments

Snow is only forecast for the end of the forecast period.
