
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow accumulations will progressively develop on bare ground to low levels through the forecast period. Greatest accumulations will build on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 700 metres. Where achieving depth, mainly in high, steep and localised wind sheltered places, accumulations will be deposited as unstable windslab. Elsewhere accumulations will be thin and on bare ground. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Light snow overnight, more prolonged during the day sometimes heavy and lying above 200 metres. Severe to storm force mainly South-Westerly winds. Freezing level at summit levels at first, lowering to 400 metres by the end of the afternoon.
