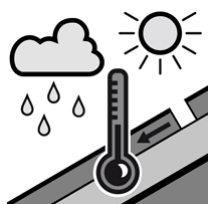
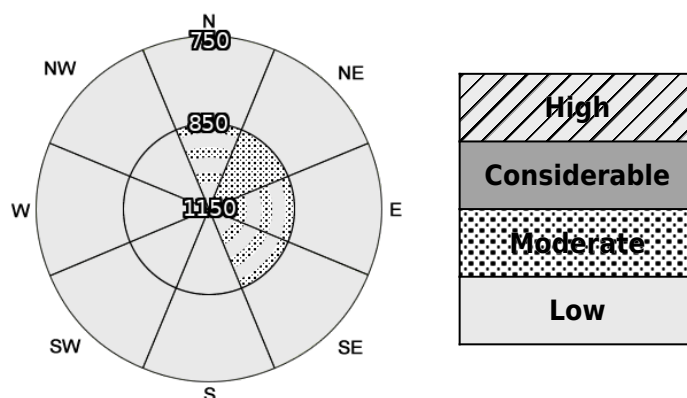


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 23/12/2016****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snow cover will be subject to thaw conditions at all levels. Wet snow instabilities will be present where deeper deposits are found on steep terrain on North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. Gully exits, corrie rims and steep convex terrain will be most affected. Elsewhere will largely become snow free. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Snow showers will ease overnight but will become heavier and turn to rain at all levels during the day. Gale force winds will be from the South-South-West veering to the West-South-West.

Freezing level will rise to above the summits early morning.
