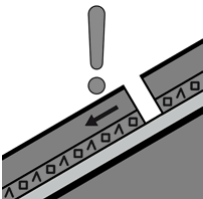


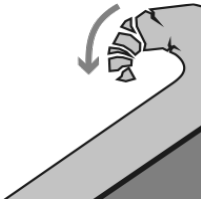

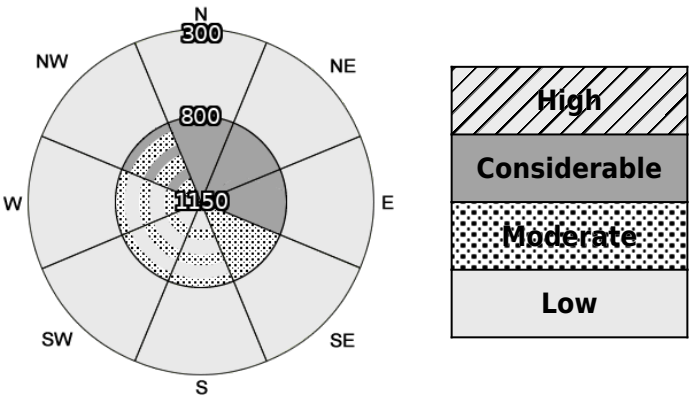

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The wet snowpack will start to re-freeze as the freezing level falls, overnight new snow accumulations will develop quickly. Deposits of unstable windslab will form again in sheltered locations above 800 metres with the greatest accumulations being on North-West through North to South-Easterly aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Colder conditions this evening, the freezing level falling to around 500 metres. Snow showers overnight, easing slightly during the day, falling down to 300 metres with severe gale to storm force Westerly winds.

Comments

Getting colder this evening with new snow arriving above 300 metres. Severe Gale force winds are forecast.
