

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will consolidate in the colder conditions. Fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop in sheltered locations. Most affected will be North-East to South-East aspects above 800 meters. Windward aspects will be scoured and hold little snow. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Showers throughout the period will fall as snow above 400 meters. The freezing level will be around 600 meters. Strong winds will be from the West.

Comments

Weather expected to remain stormy for a few days yet. Snowpack expected to evolve rapidly in these conditions.
