Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will thaw at all levels overnight and during Sunday before starting to refreeze later in the period. Localised wet snow instabilities will be present, mainly on steep North, North-East, East and South-East aspects above 900m. Elsewhere, the snowpack will be patchy and generally stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be strong from the South-West. A warm period, with rain at all levels will become established during Saturday evening and continue until Sunday afternoon before colder conditions return
