



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of wet snow instability overnight mainly on North-East to East aspects above 850m as snow turns to rain and summit temperatures become very mild indeed. Avalanches likely. All newly formed cornices will be prone to collapse during the rapid thaw. Some consolidation expected later in the day as temperatures fall. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Some overnight snow showers but then persistent rain and very mild temperatures during the day. Colder, wintry weather with snow showers expected during the afternoon. Winds will be very strong generally West-South-Westerly.

Comments

Poorest stability expected overnight and during the early part of the day.
