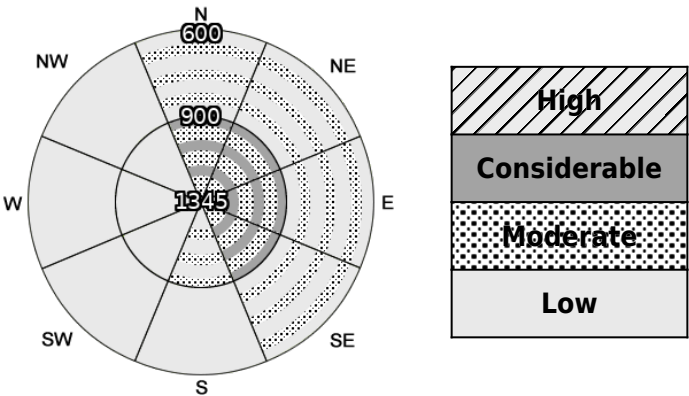
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will re-freeze in the colder temperatures and become stable. Fresh unstable windslab will be form with greatest accumulations on steep North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres with gullies and corrie rims most affected. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong, mainly Westerly winds and snow showers. Freezing level dropping to around 300 metres overnight, then rising to around 1000 metres during the day.

Comments

A return to colder conditions and snow tomorrow with the strong winds continuing.
