





Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old wet exposed snowpack will refreeze and become stable. New moderately to weakly bonded windslab will begin to accumulate and gain depth on most North-East through East to South-East aspects above 900m. Most affected will be East aspects above 850m. New weak cornice development expected over steeper lee slopes. Good stability on all wind-exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming very wintry again. Snow showers throughout the period carried on very strong West South West through West to West North West winds. Much colder.
