

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 28/12/2016


#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack which is largely confined to wind sheltered slopes on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres will continue to consolidate and will be generally well bonded and stable throughout. Any cornices over these aspects will be unstable. Many slopes are wind scoured and bare. The avalanche hazard will be Low



#### Forecast Weather Influences

It will be dry throughout the forecast period. Winds remaining strong South-Westerly. Freezing levels above the summits.
