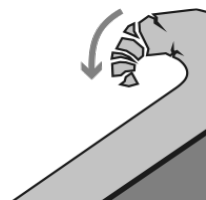
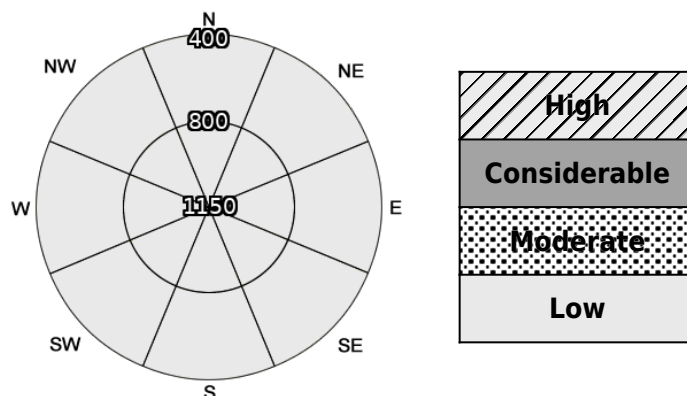


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 28/12/2016****Avalanche Problems****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The limited snow deposits which will mainly be found in sheltered locations on North through East to South-East aspects from 800 metres will continue to consolidate and will be generally well bonded. However, any cornices present on these aspects will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be dry throughout the period with strong generally South-South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will be at around 2500 metres with +1.5 degrees centigrade forecast at 930 metres at 15.00 hours.

Comments

Mixed conditions underfoot - some bare ground, some firm snow but also trail breaking required in places.
