

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 28/12/2016


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Further consolidation of the snowpack will occur and stability will improve in all locations. The greatest quantities of snow exist on upper slopes and basins above 950m. Recent cornice lines persist and will remain suspect over steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

High pressure with a mild and strong South Westerly airflow. Fluctuating temperatures with freezing levels rising above summits overnight.
