



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 29/12/2016

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will continue to consolidate and will be generally well bonded with good stability. Patchy areas of moist snow remain, mainly on steep slopes above 700 metres with a North through East to South-East aspect. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change expected. Patchy light rain will persist throughout the period with cloud over the summits. Mild; freezing level well above the summits. Strong to gale force South-South-West wind, with stronger gusts.

Comments

More of the same expected, with persistent, sometimes heavy rain into the weekend.
