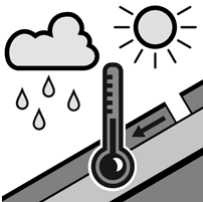


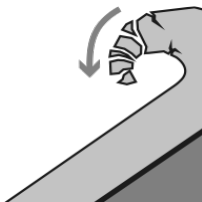

Avalanche Problems



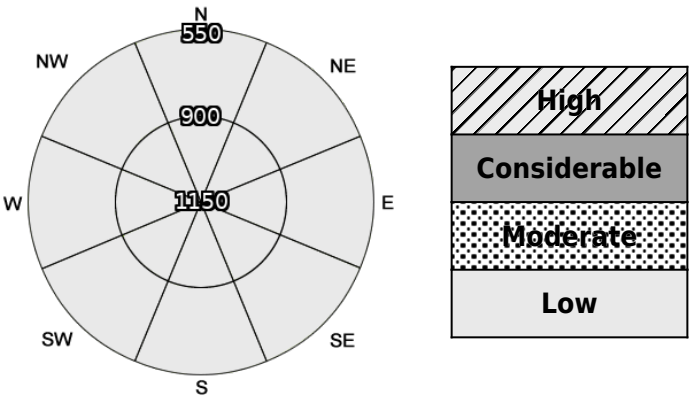
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate at all levels and stability will generally be good. The greatest snow accumulations exist on North to East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain mostly dry with the freezing well above the summits. The South-Westerly winds will be strong over the summits.

Comments

Overnight, the summits temperatures will be close to zero helping to maintain a stable snowpack, temperatures will rise again during the day.
