





Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. The snowpack will remain moist but generally well stabilised in most locations. Full depth glide cracks will continue to open on selected steep East aspects above 750m. Cornices will continue to droop as temperatures ease during the day. Ice and rock fall a consideration below some very steep crags. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Little change. Generally dry. Colder near summits overnight then a little milder. Strong South West winds.

Mizzle, flat light and a 750m cloudbase on Wednesday.
