

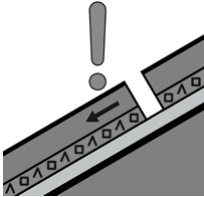

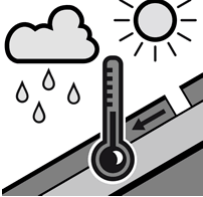

Wind Slab



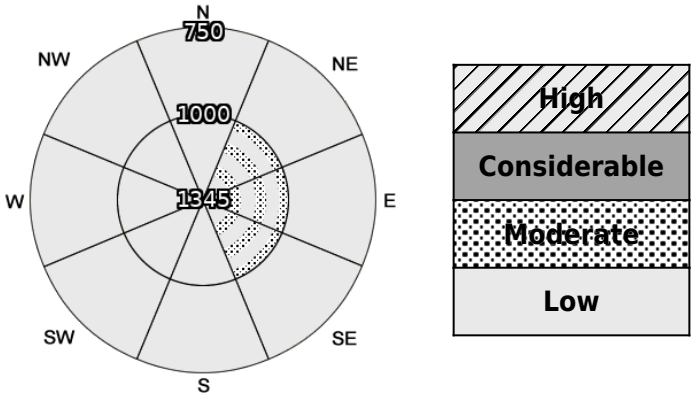
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all levels. During Saturday afternoon, the snowpack will start to refreeze above 900m. Localised fresh deposits of windslab will form during the afternoon. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 1000m. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Heavy rain at all levels with strong South-West winds dominating the weather but a return to cold and showery conditions expected later on Saturday

Strong summit winds and heavy rain continuing until Saturday afternoon
