
Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some localised wet snow instabilities will persist overnight on selected, mainly Easterly aspects. The stability of all old accumulations will improve with the arrival of cooler conditions. New moderate to weakly bonded windslab will begin to develop around coire rims late in the period, these mainly on Easterly aspects, above 900m. There will also be some cross loading in steepest gully flanks and exits of other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Further rain overnight will be heavy at times before the arrival of cooler conditions bringing snow down to all levels by end of day. The strong South winds will ease Westerly.
