
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New moderate to weakly bonded windslab will develop in steep sheltered, mainly East to South-Easterly aspects above 750m. There will be some cross loading in steepest gully flanks and exits of other aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Much cooler with snow showers above 400 metres, these will be most frequent during the morning. Moderate North-West winds will veer to the North-North-East and increase to strong during the day. The freezing level will fall to 200 metres overnight and rise to 400 metres through the afternoon.
