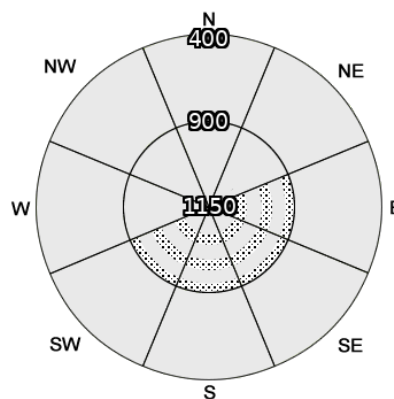

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Localised accumulations will continue to develop in sheltered locations mainly on East through South to South-West aspects above 850 metres. Where accumulations achieve depth on steep terrain they will only be moderately bonded. Elsewhere snow cover will be thin on most of the ground with older patchy snow remaining very firm and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Continuing cold with Northerly winds backing North-Westerly and remaining strong. Light snow showers in the morning will be down to around 500 metres.

Comments

Likely to be some drifting and redistribution of existing snow, particularly in the morning.
