

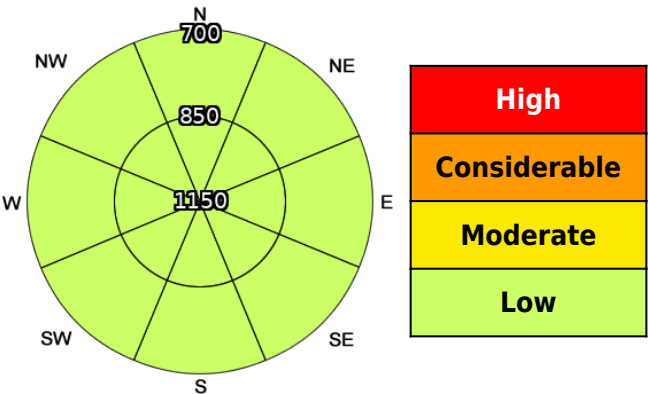

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 02/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will remain generally stable and well bonded. Any fresh deposits of snow are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The North-North-East wind will decrease and back North-Westerly into the early hours becoming fresh and generally Westerly through the day. Mainly dry, there will be very light snow showers above 400 metres through the morning. The freezing level will be around 200 metres overnight rising through the day to 800 metres.

Comments

Starting the week milder but returning to colder weather by mid-week.
