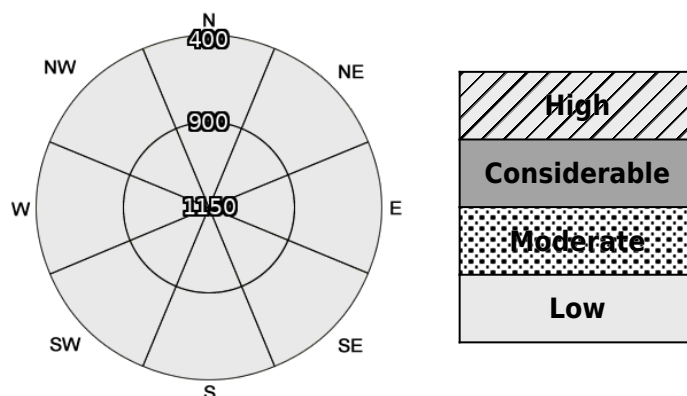


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 03/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The superficial snow cover will start to thaw at lower elevations as the freezing level rises. The localised deeper accumulations will continue to consolidate and will become generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a mainly dry day with the very strong overnight North-Westerly winds increasing to gale force and backing to the West-North-West. Fluctuating freezing level; initially rising to 2000 metres before lowering to around 1250 by mid-afternoon.
