

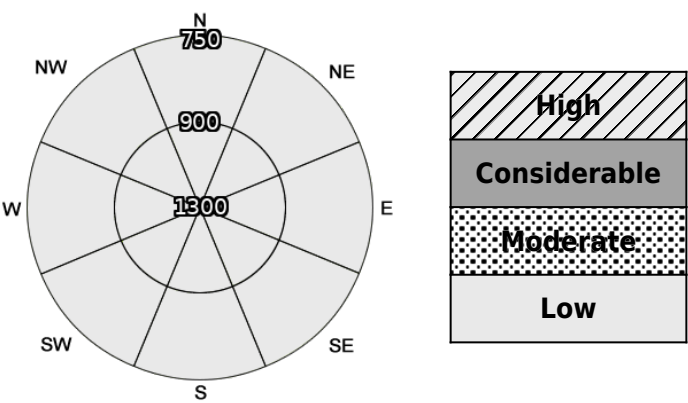

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 04/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The moist snowpack, thin in most areas but deeper on East to South aspects above 900 metres will refreeze and stabilise throughout the area. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will gradually lower overnight to 400 metres during the day. In the early evening rain will turn to snow but It will be mainly dry overnight and during the day. Winds will be mostly strong to moderate strength North-North-Westerly.

Comments

Remaining snow will re-freeze on slopes and paths, poor runouts below any snowfields.
