



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 04/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Snow cover is limited to old re-frozen snow, mainly around coire rims. Isolated patches only down to 750m. Stability of these old accumulations will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

The arrival of a cold North Westerly airflow overnight will bring settled conditions. Freezing levels will lower from summits to around 150m during the day. There will be some very light precip overnight, but it will then be a dry day. The strong overnight North Westerly winds will ease and become North, then North North Easterly by the end of the period.

Comments

Arrival of high pressure bringing more settled conditions than of late.
