

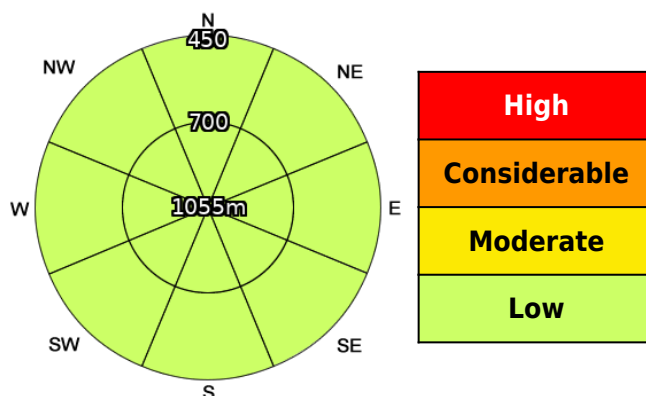
**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 06/01/2017**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

As the freezing level rises the existing patchy stable snow pack which is mainly on North-East through East to South aspects above 700 metres will soften and deplete further. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Moderate South-South-Westerly winds will veer to the West and become lighter towards the end of the day. The freezing level will rise overnight and hover around 1800 meters lowering to 1400 meters by the end of the period. Very light snow showers at first, turning to rain showers for the rest of the time.

**Comments**

A fantastic day in the hills but it felt very cold when exposed to the wind.
