

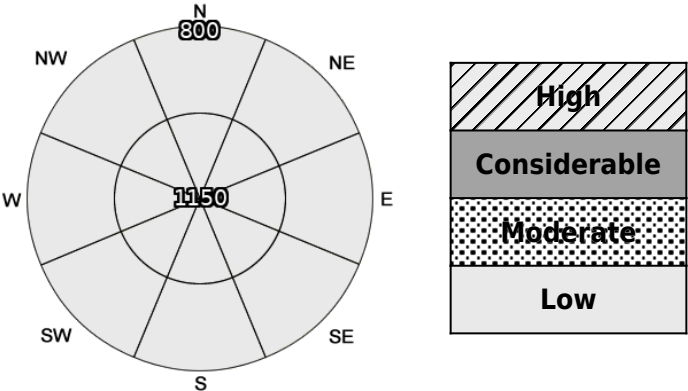

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 06/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh snow amounts are not expected to be significant. There will be some moistening and softening of the surface of the snowpack. The limited snowpack will remain generally consolidated and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The strong Southerly wind will veer Westerly in the afternoon and gradually ease becoming fresh. The freezing level will rise through the evening above the level of the summits. Rain at all levels, preceded by some light snow above 900 metres, will fall from around mid-night. Becoming drier in the afternoon.

Comments

Remaining milder and overcast into weekend but generally dry.
