

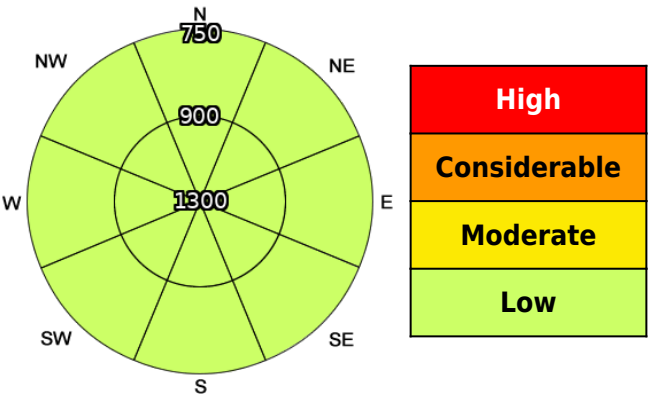

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 06/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack will soften and remain well bonded and stable in all locations. Greatest accumulations lie on East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

South-South-Westerly winds will be strong overnight, easing through the day veering to the West by the end of the day. Dry conditions expected with hill fog and mild temperatures. The freezing level will rise to well above the summits.
