

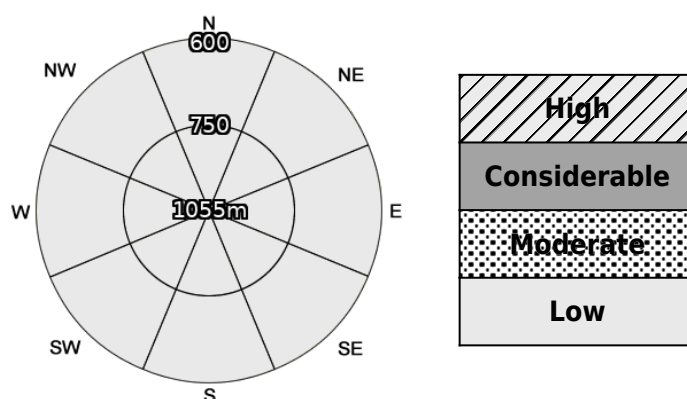

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 08/01/2017

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected; the very depleted snowpack will remain moist, firm where it gains in depth and stable. Most snow will be confined to patches and strips around coire rims, ridge flanks, tops of gullies and runnels mainly above 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The cloud, drizzle and mild conditions will continue overnight. More persistent rain is expected through the day at all levels. The freezing level will be well above the summits and the wind will generally be South-Westerly, fresh to strong on exposed tops.

Comments

A lovely morning to be in the mountains but deteriorated quickly later. The ground remains wet.
