
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will be firm well bonded and stable. Localised accumulations of new windslab will develop mostly around corrie rims and gully tops on North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A mostly dry night preceded by light rain and sleet during the early part of the morning. This will turn to light snowfall above 600 metres through the day time as the freezing level falls to 700 metres. South-Westerly winds will be severe gale to storm force.
