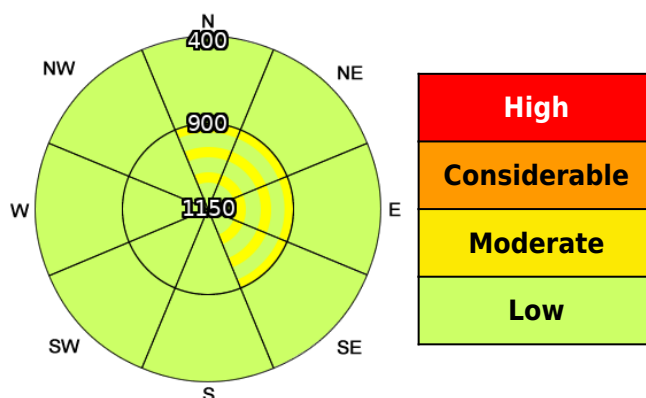


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 10/01/2017****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The old snow will become very firm with new snow mostly falling on bare ground. Localised accumulations will develop in wind sheltered locations over existing snow-ice on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Where new deposits acquire depth they will be only moderately bonded to the firm snow-ice base. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be snow showers overnight through to early afternoon above around 950 metres. Winds will be very strong from the West-North-West during the day.
